


## **Marine Corps Embassy Security Group (MCESG)**

Medical Eligibility and Overseas Screening Requirements





#### Forms:

- DD-2807-1 "Report of Medical History"
- DD-2808 "Report of Medical Examination"
- NAVMED 1300/1 "Medical, Dental and Educational Suitability Screening for Service and Family Members"
- NAVMED 1300/16 "Report of Suitability for Overseas Assignment"

These forms are available at http://ldrv.ms/f/s!Ag\_KRCZUoFsHgjKLp-mGKRRfXfI6 and are used for Medical Examinations intended for the purposes of determining eligibility and overseas screening requirements for Watchstander Candidates for Marine Security Guard (MSG) School.

A complete overseas screening and physical examination is required upon of arrival to MSG School. A complete overseas screening and physical exam consist of:

- DD 2807-1 Report of Medical History
- DD 2808 Report of Medical Examination
- NAVMED 1300/1 Medical, Dental and Educational Suitability Screening for Service and Family Members
- NAVPERS 1300/16 Report of Suitability for Overseas Assignment
- Current Hearing Test (Audiogram)

These documents MUST be signed off by a Medical/Dental Provider BEFORE arrival to MSG School. A completed copy of these forms MUST be included with your medical/dental records when you arrive at MSG School. Failure to complete these required forms will potentially delay or disqualify you from the MSG Program.

#### COPIES of POOR QUALITY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Medical and Dental records are REQUIRED for this PCS move.

Always keep copies for your personal records.

## **Instructions for Completing Forms**

Complete these forms prior to arrival to MSG school

## DD 2807-1 Report of Medical History:

- 1. Complete blocks 1 9. Please write legibly.
- 2. For blocks 10 28 answer the medical questions as they apply to you. If you have any "YES" answers, give a brief explanation in block 29 on page 2.
- 3. Ensure that your name and full SSN are filled in at the top of each page.

### DD 2808 Report of Medical Examination:

- 1. Complete blocks 1-11a, 13, and 15a-16. Please write legibly.
- 2. In block 15c, mark "Other"
- 3. Do not mark or fill out anything in blocks 17 or any other numbered block, unless the examining medical/dental provider instructs you to do so. The remaining blocks are for the medical/dental provider completing the medical/dental exams only.
- 4. Fill in your personal information at the top of pages two and three.

### NAVMED 1300/1 Medical, Dental and Educational Suitability Screening of Service / Family Members:

- 1. Fill in your personal information at the top of pages one and three.
- 2. Do not answer any of the medical questions on this form. They are to be completed by medical and dental personnel only.
- 3. Page three is to be completed by a civilian or DOD dental provider. The dentist should refer to Box 8 for descriptions of the four dental classifications.

#### NAVPERS 1300/16 Report of Suitability for Overseas Assignment:

- 1. Fill in your personal information at the top of each page.
- 2. Answer questions 1-16 on pages one and two. Note (for personnel E-4 and below you must be counseled on questions 1-16 by a senior member in your chain of command).
- 3. Page four will be filled out by your administrative department AFTER your medical screening has been completed.
